General Information

Both symbolise Saint John's first Chapter, THE WORD in design B, and further development of the theme in design A, The Light and The Spirit, - the open book of the Gospels, Christ the Light of the World, and the descending Dove of the Holy Spirit.

It is our thought to develop this general idea through the entire series in various aspects and attributes of Our Lord, as suggested through Saint John's Gospel, - Christ the Door, the Good Shepherd, the Healer, the Teacher, Saviour, etc.

In the more developed plan Christ could be represented teaching in the Temple. His Miracles could be introduced in the Feeding of the five thousand, suggesting the Bread of Life; Changing Water to Wine in the First Miracle; Walking on the Sea; and the Draught of Fishes.

Design B can be developed at a cost of three hundred dollars each lancet, or nine hundred for a group of three; while the more elaborate and significant arrangement would cost about five hundred dollars each lancet, or fifteen hundred each group. Either plan involves the same type of brilliant and colorful glass, and equally fine craftsmanship.
