General Information **To be devoted to Saint Augustin of Canterbury and Saint Columba.**

(See photograph of opposite clerestory window in place. )

The clerestory window is devoted to Saint Augustine of Canterbury and Saint Columba.

Saint Augustine bears the staff and book inscribed with the cross, and at his feet is the spring that miraculously appeared when he struck the ground with his staff when he needed water to baptise converts.

At Saint Columba's feet is the boat (coracle) in which he sailed to Iona.
