General Information They have 17 windows in the basement Chapel for which Hope is making metal frames - 13 of one size in the main church, and two narrower ones in side transepts, and two wider ones in the Sacristy.

Monsignor McNulty likes the idea of the Laconia and Fairhaven windows, except he wants more color in the fields.

Make rough sketches, one with symbol in the upper part, and another with a figure of a saint, as in the Saint Mary's, Fall River, only a little larger and lower.
