General Information Octagonal Window

This is to be a hanging panel in the top of the church. The 8 supporting beams go up to an octagonal vent about 3 feet in diameter at the top. The idea is to hang an octagonal panel of stained glass below that vent, illuminating it artificially from above. To have a Christian symbol suggesting aspiration, heavenly reaches etc.

We have been studying the hanging panel for the peak of the church and are sending a rough sketch for it. The symbols are the Stars of Heavenly Steadfastness and Flames of Religious Zeal.

The eight pointed Star with secondary Stars might stand for the Beatitudes, while the four flames and the four pointed star suggest the Evangelists.

We have thought of many other symbols but these seem most appropriate for the position, and the design should be equally effective from all view points.

We have in mind a sturdy L and T armature and rugged leads for adequate support.

It is very difficult to estimate the cost, having no real precedent for such an arrangement. We are hoping to keep it in the neighborhood of one thousand dollars.
