General Information #7 Good Samaritan and Peter's Confession

The Parable of the Good Samaritan is the great symbol of Our Lord's compassion.

The final pair on the Gospel side is given to Our Lord's Parable of the Good Samaritan; and Saint Peter's Confession.

The compassionate traveler comes to the aid of the unfortunate man who has fallen among thieves. The Priest and Levite pass above, (they will be given form and clarity in the full size rendering)

Above is the Cross Potent or cross of healing; (said to be made up of four ancient crutches placed point to point). Below is the Inn to which the Good Samaritan took the injured man.

Saint Peter acknowledges Our Lord, - "Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God."

Above are the keys of the kingdom of Heaven, and below the symbol of the Church, - "upon this rock I will build My Church."
