General Information..... The Four Prophets.

Four Windows in the Parish House.

Devoted to the Prophets who foretold the coming of Christ, leading up to the windows devoted to His Life. This has often been a traditional arrangement.

The first of the Major Prophets is Isaiah. He holds the tongs and coal of fire with which the Angel cleansed his speech. The symbol of the Christ Child in the manger recalls his prophecy of the Advent (66:7). Jeremiah holds the chains, foretelling the captivity of Israel (Chapter 28). The symbol of lightning striking the structures below refers to the destruction of Jerusalem (35:16).

With Ezekiel are symbols of the four winged beasts (1:10), with the Chi Rho symbol of Christ below, - the Cross forming shepherd's crooks (34:23).

Daniel holds the scales, - "Thou art weighed in the balances and art found wanting (5:27). The familiar lions are symbolized below.

In the tops are winged trumpets, symbols of prophecy, and the flames accenting the foliated borders imply Heavenly zeal.
