 In the left panel Our Lord holds a small child in His lap,
 while another brings Him flowers. Opposite a mother brings
 children to Him for blessing.**

**The dominant symbols below are the Baptismal Font with the
 Dove of the Holy Spirit hovering over it, and the traditional
 symbol of the Fountain of Living Waters, from which two deer
 drink.**

**Personal symbols include the artists' Palette and Brushes,
 a Sailboat, Ocean Waves, Flowers* and Birds** suggesting the
 beauty of nature.**

For "flowers" use white violet

For "birds" use a Chickadee
