The Lord's Prayer symbolized in three panels

We have completed our study of the design for the group of three Chapel windows in Building No. 1 and are sending you our color sketch, herewith.

As planned, they are devoted to the symbolism of the Lord's Prayer.

The first(left) panel represents Our Father by the six-pointed Creator's Star. It is in radiant white, the traditional color of purity. It is surrounded by heavenly blue and Hallowed golden glow. The crown suggests "Thy kingdom come". Ruby is the symbolic color of Divine Love.

"Thy will be done" is symbolized is symbolized by the sacramental Chalice in the central panel, while the green circle and surrounding blue recall earth and heaven. Two loaves with the Chalice stand for, "Our daily bread". The scales of Justice symbolize the plea for forgiveness, "as we forgive". The deep blue is the color of contemplation and truth.

In the final panel, the serpent symbolizes temptation and evil struck down by Divine light from the golden city, the seat of the "Kingdom, the power and the glory, forever."
