Prophet window

The north transept window is designed to balance, and to a degree, harmonize with the one in the south transept. Though much more colorful, its ornamental, architectural "canopy" will relate well to the opposite window.

It is devoted to Prophecy, and we have represented the figures of the major prophets, Jeremiah, Isaiah and Ezekiel. At the center is the dominant figure of Isaiah. He holds the prophetic scroll inscribed with the text, - "Make straight in the desert a highway for our God." Above is the symbolic coal of fire with which his lips were cleansed and purified. Jeremiah holds the broken chains of bondage, and Ezekiel, - the torch of freedom and enlightenment.

Near the top of the central lancet is the six pointed Creator's star of the Old Testament.

Other prophets could be substituted if you wish, such as Amos or Hosea.

At present, we believe, this window can be made and installed as designed, at a cost of twenty-four hundred dollars.

Secondary, related subjects in the predellas, similar to those we have introduced in the design of the west window, would increase the cost by about four hundred dollars.
