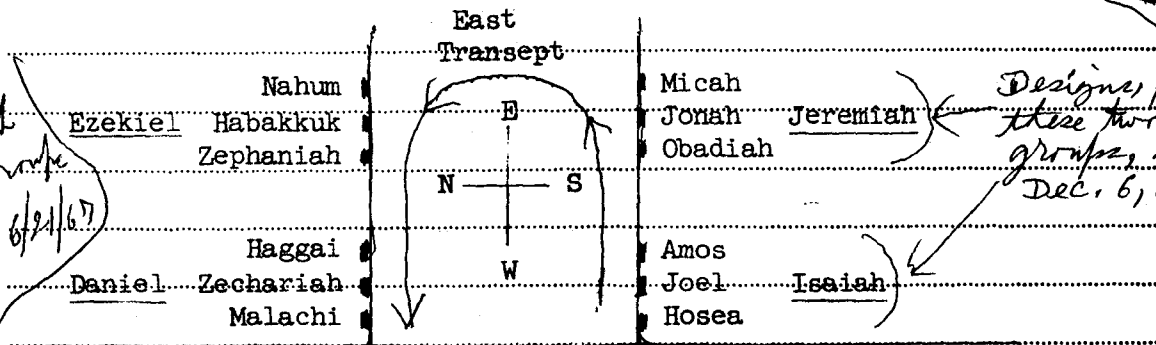

The Major Prophets Isaiah and Jeremiah occupy the central positions,- Isaiah with the tongs and burning coal with which his lips were purified; Jeremiah with the chains of bondage and the wand or torch of freedom.

We have followed the Biblical arrangement, finding difficulties in other plans.

The Minor Prophets start with Hosea with the cast-off mantle representing the infidelity of Israel, and the shattered idol.

Traditionally, Joel wears a pointed hood and carries the trumpet of Zion; Amos has the shepherd's crook; Obadiah, a pitcher and basket of bread; Jonah emerges from the great fish, and Micah stands with the broken sword beside a Temple.

We have completed our study of the designs for the north windows of your east transept and are sending the color sketches, herewith.

Continuing the sequence, nearest the east end, Nahum is represented with the yoke.(1-13).

Near Ezekiel are the four winged creatures in the whirlwind with faces of man, lion, ox, and eagle.(1-10). Below, Habakkuk with stringed instrument, stands upon the tower.(3-19; 2-1).

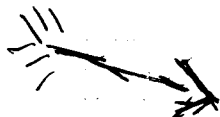
Beside Zephaniah the sword symbolizes alarm against fenced cities and high towers.

With Haggai, in the final group, is the house in which the Lord will take pleasure and be glorified, symbolized by the ray of Divine light from Heaven. (1-8).

Daniel is represented with his lions, and Zechariah with the red horse in his vision.(1-8).

Finally, Malachi is accompanied by the Angel from the clouds.

We will keep in mind using more clear glass for these panels.

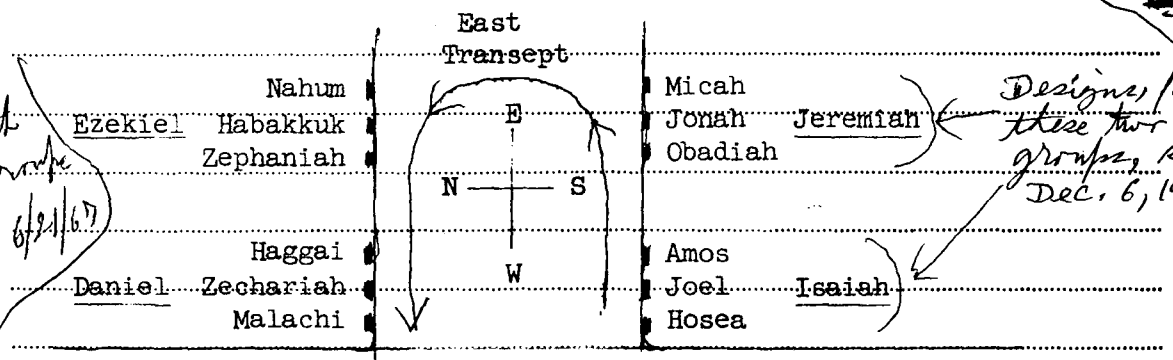

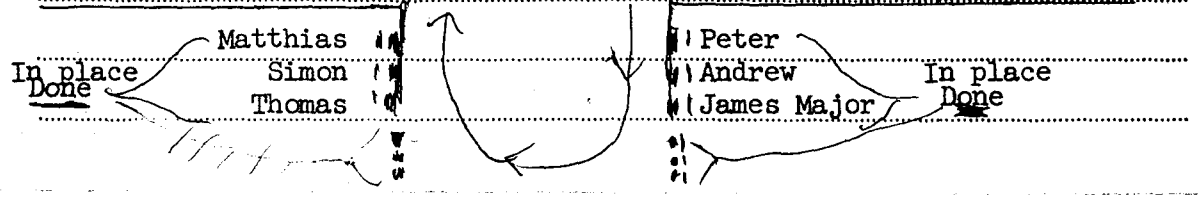
