
We can make the two end windows, Samuel and David, at a cost of seven hundred dollars each. The Nativity can also be made for that amount, but the last two compositions,—Christ in the Temple, and the Flight into Egupt, involve more time and study in figure compositions and should be seven hundred and twenty-five dollars.

We are very glad to have your good message, and to make the additional sketch to represent Christ Blessing little Children. We are sending it, herewith.

I imagine you did not mean to make the whole window in the figure composition as we did at Saint Gabriel's Church, Marion, but rather to use the figure composition in the medallion with the surrounding field in harmony with the other windows. In the full size drawings we can make the figures and entire compsition even more like the Marion window. As designed it will bring the cost to eight hundred and fifty dollars (\$850). In this manner, taking its place with the others to excellent purpose.
