We have represented Saint Michael's flaming sword and shield as the tracery symbol surrounded by flames of Divine zeal in fields of ruby. His scales of justice occupy the lancet head. In his shining white armor and surcoat inscribed with the cross, he overcomes the dragon with his crossed staff.

Medallion below . . . We have substituted the Nativity of Our Lord in place of the Expulsion in the Saint Michael window. The Blessed Virgin holds the Christ Child, while Saint Michael as the guardian is represented according to the passage in Mrs. Clement's book, ANGELS IN ART, - "...In all humility he is in the act of worship before the Divine Infant, or stands in reverent attitude near the Madonna, as if to guard Her and Her heaven-sent Son."

Heavenly crowns are spotted through the foliated field.

This design will be carefully developed in line and form and proportion, in a manner comparable to the Transfiguration window. We have suggested a warmer palette, and it will have a lovely bright effect in the morning light. As the sun moves around toward the south it will become somewhat more subdued and the side windows will come into greater prominence.
