General Information Saints Andrew and Barnabas

Carrying on the symbolism of the Fruit of the Spirit, this window is devoted to Saint Andrew (Meekness), and Saint Barnabas (Faith). Saint Andrew holds the closed book and diagonal Cross of his martyrdom, while Saint Barnabas bears the Latin Cross and stones, also in reference to his martyrdom.

Below are the Washing of Peter's feet (an act of Meekness and the Fig Tree (a lesson of Faith).

Again, the text and citations are included,-

"If I wash thee not thou has no part with me" (St. John 13:8), -----

"Whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, ye shall receive" (St. Matthew 21:22).

These windows alternate in color scheme. This one accents the warmer colors with light gold fields. Smaller areas of ruby and blue are counterchanged to maintain the over-all color harmony.

The growing vine form outlining the medallions and enriching the fields come to fruit in the Pomegranate, traditional symbol of the spirit of the Gospel and the fruitfulness of the Church.
