General Information..... Our window is different from any of the others, but will be in excellent harmony with them, especially the one directly across from it.

For your design, we have included the traditional architectural "canopy" motif, in harmony with others of the series, with the central panel designed in a conventional rose pattern and Divine Love, entwined around the Cross, with the Scroll above.

(Symbols to be: Scroll: Lamp of Knowledge; and the Scales).
The Lamp near the father's name - George Willis Patterson
The Scales " " brother's name - Arthur Willis Patterson
(father at the left - - - brother at the right)

With the usual "In Loving Memory of" above them.

The small cross can be omitted from the Scroll if you wish, simply indicating a few lines.

We have followed the plan of the opposite window, placing the memorial inscriptions in the base panel.

This lower panel is a ventilator section in many of the windows. Fortunately, they do not need the ventilation in this one, but we are keeping the line, to correspond with the others.

Colors are well balanced between the cool and warm tones again with an over-all harmony in mind.
