General Information "Anchor Cross"

Field light blues, a little lighter than the first pair. Medallions about the same size, or a little smaller. Perhaps a ruby background with gold Anchor

In studying the door light we found two solutions to the problem and could not decide which we liked best, so we are sending both sketches.

One involves a medallion shape that might suggest the Trinity, while the other is a little more formal and rectangular. Either one would harmonize well with the present door lights, and we think either can be made and installed at a cost of two hundred dollars, including the inscription, "Arthur J. Donahue", with years of birth and death, if desired.
