Our Lord's Appearance to Mary Magdalene.

This window is devoted to Our Lord's appearance to Mary Magdalene after His Resurrection.

The medallion below the risen Christ represents Saints Peter and John arriving at the empty tomb.

Below Mary Magdalene is the Supper at Emmaus when Our Lord revealed Himself to His traveling companions.

In the tracery member at the top is the cruciform banner of victory over death.

The positions of principal colors, ruby and blue, are reversed from the arrangement in the windows at either side; adding interest and variation, without disturbing the overall balance.
