General Information..... Christ at the home of Mary and Martha

Martha and Mary are represented below, - Martha, busy about her household duties (carrying a bowl to the table), and Mary kneeling in prayer. Our Lord, seated, holds an open book inscribed with the reference from Saint Luke's Gospel (this could be replaced with a decorative form of the cross, if you prefer). ~~At the base is the text, - "Mary hath chosen that good part."~~

At the top is the vase of precious ointment often associated with Mary.

We have represented Christ in garments of blue and white, ancient color symbols of Heavenly contemplation and purity. This arrangement will balance well with the companion window, but if you prefer, the color arrangement can be reversed, with blue border, ruby background for the foliated pattern, blue fields in the medallions and a ruby cloak for Our Lord.
