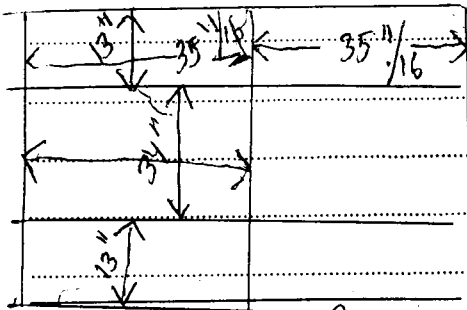

We have completed the color designs for your lower windows and are sending them to you, herewith.

As planned, they are devoted to the life of Our Lord starting with the Nativity and the Flight into Egypt. The Three Wise Men, or Kings are indicated near Joseph and Mary and the Christ Child in the manger. Pyramids in the background suggest the location of the flight.

Next is the young Christ in the Temple, disputing with the Doctors, - the Commandments above. The companion panel symbolizes the Baptism of Our Lord, with Saint John the Baptist holding the Shell, and the descending Dove of the Holy Spirit in the rays of light from Heaven.

In the Mount of Temptation, Satan tempts Christ with the crown of the kingdoms of the world, while Our Lord gestures toward the Kingdom of Heaven. At the Wedding Miracle, Christ turns water to wine, while the bride and groom wait at table.

Our Lord converses with the Woman at Jacob's Well; and teaches the way of true Christian life at the Mount of the Beatitudes. The eight pointed Cross is their traditional symbol.

He heals the Blind, and Blesses the Children.

At the opposite side, the door panels continue with the story with Palm Sunday, and Driving out the Money -changers.

Then the Last Supper, and the Prayer in the Garden of Gethsemane, again with the ray of Divine light in blessing from Heaven.

Christ stands before Pilate as he washes his hands, carries the Cross; and finally, the Resurrection and Pentecost.
