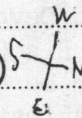

General Information

As suggested, Our Lord as the Good Shepherd, with crook and a lamb in his arms, is the dominant theme. Accompanying Him in the side panels are twelve sheep that have traditionally symbolized His Apostles. This theme could well be continued and developed in the side windows of the church in an overall harmonious plan.

Our Lord and the sheep are in white, the color of purity, while the fields are in various tones of blue, the color of Heavenly contemplation. Accents of ruby suggest Divine love, green for Heavenly promise and growth, with touches of gold for treasures in Heaven, and a suggestion of Heavenly mansions at the top.

We have in mind the possibility of removing the present sash, making somewhat larger glass areas.
