Donor is very fond of the blues used in the windows and would like, if possible, to have blue predominate in this window. The blue used in the Pentecost window that Frances designed seems to be what he has in mind. It is located in the same aisle group as the Reformation window - it is east end of the group. Of course there are blues in all those which have been completed but not predominate. Would it be out of line to go a

little stronger with the blues to satisfy him and still be in keeping with the other windows?

Mr. Skinner wrote as follows:

"I believe this is the one that has the red borders and medallion backgrounds in the alternating arrangement, but we can minimize and hold them down while emphasizing the blues of the fields, rosettes and figures, providing a goodly amount of the type of blue used in the Pentecost window."
