The second pair on the Gospel side is devoted to the Baptism of Christ and His Temptation.

Our Lord stands in the Jordan, while Saint John the Baptist, with crossed staff baptizes Him from the shell. Rays of Divine light descend upon Him.

Above is the symbol of Shell and Water of Baptism, and below, the Font, again in rays of blessing.

The tempter offers Christ the crown of the kingdoms of the world, with their glory shining in the background. An Angel comes to minister unto Him.

Above is the Cross and Heavenly Crown, and below, the tempting serpent in the Garden of Eden.
