**The Father Andrews Memorial Window,  
Church of the Good Shepherd, Dedham, Massachusetts**

This window is devoted to the Calling of the Disciples to be  
Fishers of Men.

Our Lord stands on the shore beckoning to Peter and Andrew who  
have come ashore, while James and John are stillin their boat.  
Nets are near by and birds of the sea hover above.

The shells in the tracery members suggest the sea, and are  
also symbols of Baptism.

In the base medallions are Fishes, traditional emblem of  
Christ, and the Anchor of Faith and Hope.

Personal symbols are suggested through the fields, a camp and  
pine trees of Maine, and a camp fire with cooking kettle, ship, buoy,  
and lighthouse, with a space indicated for an appropriate British  
Marine symbol.

For "camp" a cabin, (not a tent)

For "Marine symbol" Merchant Marine Flag
