General Information "Saint Bartholomew" "Saint John the Baptist"

the color sketch for the one devoted to Saint Bartholomew.

He holds his traditional symbol, the book, while the symbol of his martyrdom, the flaying knife, is represented below.

In the head of the lancet is the fig, recalling the place of his calling, as recorded in the first chapter, forty-eighth verse of Saint John's Gospel.

We are preparing the design for the companion window to be devoted to Saint John the Baptist and will send it to you, soon.

It is devoted to Saint John the Baptist. He wears camel's hair and rough garments of the wilderness and carries his crossed staff and banner inscribed, - "Ecce Agnus Dei." Water is at his feet, and the symbol of the Lamb of God, above.

Shells of baptism are designed in the base and the two tracery members.
