

The Duncombe Memorial

Designed in harmony with the others, the main symbol is the Hand of God from the clouds. He has the little book, - "Symbols of the Church", and he looked at page 7, - the bottom one. From it could be rather freely designed descending rays of Divine light. Above would be a little canopy to reflect the end transept window near-by. What background there is should suggest a rectangular pattern. Near the base would be a fairly small beehive, and with the memorial inscription, still smaller crossed mallet and saw on one side, and the two of Hearts (card) on the other. *eliminated*

Above as a text, "O God ... whose service is perfect freedom" from Morning Prayer for Peace *eliminated*

Their birth stones are the sapphire, and they mentioned cathedral blue (a fairly light blue) and garnet, - colors to be used in spots.
