Peter, John, and the cripple in the left lancet;
Christ forgiving Mary Magdalene in the right panel.

At the left, Saint Peter commands the lame man,
"Rise up and walk" (The Acts 3:6).

On the shield below are inscribed with the symbols of
two of the Sacraments, - Penance with the crossed keys of Saint Peter,
and Unction, the oil cruet on the cross.

A Pharisee - referring to the Law of Moses.

Christ forgiving Mary Magdalene, and Saints Peter and
John and the cripple. For the first the text is, - "Neither do I
condemn thee". (St. John 8:11).

The surrounding decorative "canopy" is not drawn in
as it will be developed in keeping with the others as shown in the
next, the HALL window, - Christ Blessing Children.

Border symbols - a hammer - a butterfly - a shepherd's crook -
a thistle - a boat - a Godfrey Cross (worn by Godfrey de Bouillon) and a
VICLIN AND A HORN (MUSICAL)
