David, sweet singer of Israel, is crowned as king and carries the sceptre. He holds a scroll inscribed with the text from his one hundred and fiftieth psalm. -"Praise Him with the sound of the trumpet."

(In the actual window it could go on with the rest of the verse; - "Praise Him with the psaltery and harp;" or any of several other appropriate texts, as you know).

Below, the young David plays his harp to soothe the troubled Saul. The field is decorated with architectural "canopy", suggesting the temple. This type of enrichment is traditional in stained glass since the twelfth and thirteen centuries.

In the tracery above are ancient types of musical instruments, the six pointed star of David, members of the angelic choir playing musical instruments, and scrolls of music.

The base, which is partly obscured by the pew back, is kept simple. The memorial inscription could be raised if you wish.
