The Good Samaritan - 3 medallions

The story reads upward. The wounded man is represented in the lower medallion, with the thieves fleeing at one side, and the Priest and LEVITE passing on the other.

At the center, the compassionate traveller ministers to the unfortunate man. His donkey stands near by.

At the top, the Good Samaritan is seating his man on his own beast for the trip to the inn, symbolized at the upper left.

Over all is the descending Dove of the Holy Spirit.
