Saint Paul

Designed in harmony with its companions, Saint Paul holds the open book with a suggestion of his significant theme, "Faith, Hope and Love (or Charity)". We could represent these words, or the text, - "The greatest of these is charity."

In the field is his traditional symbol of the three fountains (wavy blue and white lines), recalling the miracle at his martyrdom. In the rose border is another of his traditional symbols, the crossed swords, also recalling his martyrdom as well as the Sword of the Spirit.

The inscription is designed at the base, - "Gift of the Frederic B. Smith Family."
