The principal symbol to be the Town Seal (without the surrounding lettering,) and in the colors I noted from the flag in the Town Courtroom

*** We should look for a good text, implying civic service. Perhaps something in Paul's writings. The scales as a secondary symbol below, and perhaps a fireman's helmet, and the Liberty cap, very small with the memorial inscription. The Liberty Cap is part of the new Symbol they are designing for the fire department,; and the fireman's helmet is part of the old symbol.
