General Information..... "Christ Child's Presentation in the Temple"

The theme is the significant incident of the Christ Child's Presentation in the Temple, as related in the second chapter of Saint Luke's Gospel.

Mary the mother stands before the altar with the just and devout Simeon holding the Christ Child in his arms. "It was revealed unto him by the Holy Ghost that he should not see death before he had seen the Lord's Christ". "For mine eyes have seen thy salvation, which thou hast prepared before the face of all people; a light to lighten the Gentiles and the glory of thy Israel". Between them, in the wire basket, is the offering of Doves. Joseph with his traditional flowering ~~stands~~ stands in the background.

Space for the memorial inscription is indicated at the base, with the symbol of the Scales of Justice.

The foliated and flowering border is similar to that in the companion window, but with interesting color changes, - blue in place of ruby.
